MOWER RULES

1. Mower must be a factory available lawn or garden mower (no homemade frames).
2. No rear engine lawn mowers are allowed.
3. Engine must be a **factory** mower engine.
4. Transaxles must be factory available mower transaxles. Reinforcing and/or welding of spider gears is permitted.
5. Engine bay reinforcing is permitted but must be contained inside of the hood & must maintain factory body lines.
6. All mowers must run factory hood & fenders. The hood should be screwed or welded down to the dash panel around the driver's area.
Note: If the hood is fiberglass, a sheet metal hood can be made but it must be the same size as the fiberglass one.
7. Mowers must have working brakes and forward/reverse gears at the start of the heat.
8. Gas tank must be secured and have a cap on it. If any gas is leaking, the mower will be shut down.
9. Leg guards are **mandatory** and must be bolted and/or welded from rear fender to front of foot rest or frame.
10. A rear bumper is permitted but is not allowed to extend more than 4" out and must stay in between the tires. No spikes or sharp edges.
11. Re-gearing and changing of pulleys to increase speed is permitted and encouraged.
12. All mowers must use mower type wheels. Tractor treads & cut tires are permitted. Tire chains and dual wheels are not permitted.
13. Mower decks must be removed.
14. All head lights & any other glass/plastics must be removed.
15. Batteries must be removed from mower and can be used only to jump start the mower before the heat begins. If a pull start is used, the driver will not be permitted to restart the engine during the heat.
16. If a mower is rolled over, that driver is out. Also, if the driver's hand or foot touches the ground, that driver is out.
17. For safety purposes - if a mower is rolled over, all drivers must stop & wait until the officials restart the heat.
18. Put your number on each side of your mower and/or your helmet.
19. Entry fee is \$20.
